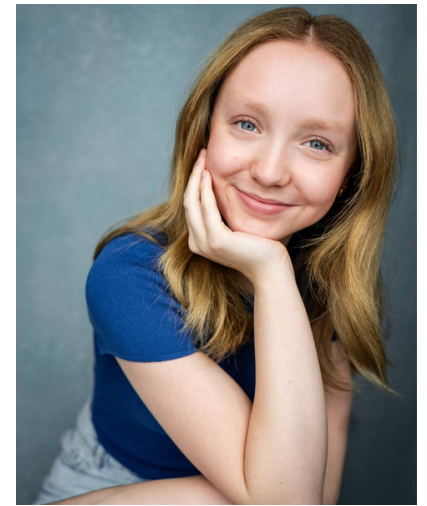

Training

Reference from Charlotte Keatley: Bebe played the part of Rosie in my landmark play "My Mother Said I Never Should", which I adapted into two 1 hour dramas. I have 40 years of making radio, theatre and television. Bebe was recommended to me by Nadia the director and the other BBC producers. Bebe was the only member of the cast who had to play her character from the age 8 to young adult. She is an actor with great range both physically and vocally. She gave a tremendous performance of the shifting age of this character, in humour and outlook, as well as more subtly in the emotional growth. Bebe clearly does a great deal of preparation yet carries this lightly and is excellent at taking direction. We were often recording scenes under time pressure and Bebe could absorb notes quickly and adjust her performance between takes. It was clear she had considered all the options and layers to the scenes and was ready to try whatever was asked of her. She is an intelligent actor and a great addition to the room as she is alert to what others are doing in the scene. She will offer suggestions if asked but is a calm presence. Bebe has good instincts and timing for humour. What really stands out is how she can convey the emotional depths the character goes through as a teenager. She works with genuine commitment to the craft of acting and a total focus. I highly recommend working with Bebe Massey.
