From Feature Films to playing Santa - his scope is wide. Recent credits include Teddy Deakin in *Ghost Train* (Trinity Theatre Club, 2025), Waylon in *Rapunzel* (Borough Green and Platt Players, 2025), and Gaston in *Beauty and the Beast* (Chip Productions, 2025). Andrew's flair for eccentric and larger-than-life roles shines in performances such as Sir Harvey Bristol Karim in *One Night in Shanghai* (2023), Felix Waterford in *Truffle at Mill* (2023), and the Genie in *Alladin* (2019). Earlier standout roles include Wacky Gangster Dog in *Catastrophie at 47a* (2018), showcasing his comedic timing and physical theatre skills. A highly skilled storyteller and voice-over artist with a home studio, Andrew excels in comedy, presenting, and character work. His musical talents include ukulele and guitar, and he's a trained barber—adding authenticity to period and working-class roles. Physically adept, he's skilled in swimming and weightlifting, and holds a full car driving licence.
